

Subject: Filling up of 400 (four hundred) posts of Rifleman in EFR Battalion under West Bengal Police through West Bengal Police Recruitment Board.

Whereas the State Government has approved the proposal for filling up of 400 posts of Rifleman by direct recruitment in EFR Battalion under West Bengal Police vide Notification No.635-PL/PB/3P-12/2022 dated 07.03.2024;
