NOTIFICATION

No. 311-PL/PA/1C-10/05 (Pt. II), dated 09/02/2024. – In exercise of the power conferred by sub-section (1) of Section 9A of the Calcutta Police Act, 1866 (Ben. Act IV of 1866), read with sub-section (1) of section 3A of the Calcutta Suburban Police Act, 1866 (Ben. Act II of 1866), the Governor is pleased hereby to make, with immediate effect, the following amendments in the Calcutta Police (Sub-Inspector and Sub-Inspectress) Recruitment Rules, 2023, issued under this Department notification No. 224-PL/PE/15S-205/21 dated 01.02.2023 (hereinafter referred to as the said rules):—

Amendments

In the said rules,—

(1) for clause (d) of rule 5, *substitute* the following clause:—

"(d) age of the candidate must not be less than 20 (twenty) years and not more than 30 (thirty) years as on the 1st day of January of the year of advertisement:

Provided that the upper age-limit shall be relaxable by 5 (five) years in case of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes candidates, by 3 (three) years in case of Other Backward Classes-A and Other Backward Classes-B candidates and by 3 (three) years in the case of transgender persons;"

(2) for rule 10, *substitute* the following rule :

"10. Reservation of Posts.— The reservation of posts for Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Classes-A, Other Backward Classes-B and Economically Weaker Sections categories shall be as per orders issued by the State Government from time to time."
