No. 2910-PL/PB/4P-17/2021 dated 28/11/2024 : In exercise of the power conferred by clause(u) of sub-section (1) of section 2 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (46 of 2023) and in modification of all Previous Notifications on the subject, the Governor is hereby pleased to declare that with effect from the date of publication of this Notification in the Official Gazette, the Dum Dum GRPS under Sealdah GRP district shall include the following areas, Railway Stations comprising the lands and properties belonging to the Railway, situated along the entire length of the Railway track specified in the schedule below and in accordance with regulation 550 of Police Regulations of Bengal, 1943 :-
