Rules

The method of recruitment to the post of Engineer-in-chief in the Public Health Engineering Department, Government of West Bengal, shall be such as detailed below:—

1) **Method of recruitment:**— By promotion from amongst the eligible Chief Engineers belonging to the West Bengal Senior Public Health Engineering Service, Civil and Mechanical/ Electrical, having minimum of one (1) year service in the post of Chief Engineer and completing 30 (thirty) years of total service in the West Bengal Public Health Engineering Service as well as in the West Bengal Senior Public Health Engineering Service, on the recommendation of the Departmental Promotion Committee (DPC).

NOTE— The Departmental Promotion Committee (DPC) shall consist of the followings:—

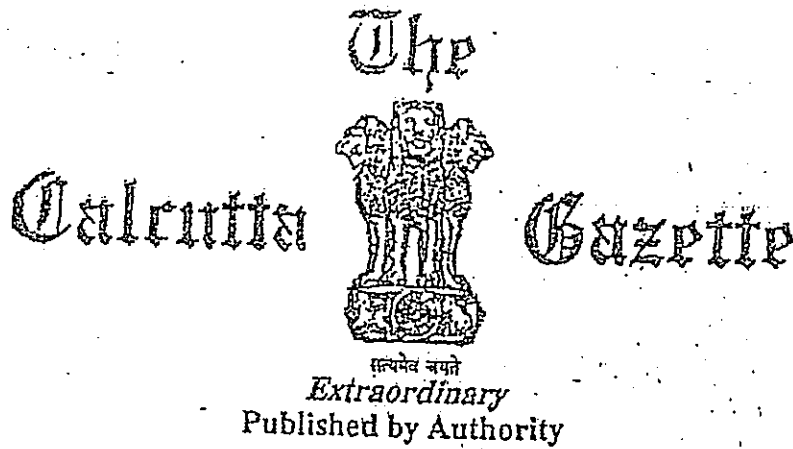

No. PHE/Estt/2082/2E-113/92.—21st November 1994.—In exercise of the power conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India and in supersession of all previous rules on the subject, the Governor is pleased hereby to make the following rules for the regulation of recruitment to and the conditions of service in the Engineering Services (Civil) of the Public Health Engineering Directorate under the Department of Public Health Engineering, Government of West Bengal, namely;

Rules for the regulation of Recruitment to and the conditions of service in the Engineering Services (Civil) of the Public Health Engineering Directorate under the Department of Public Health Engineering, Government of West Bengal.

1. These rules shall apply to the members of the Engineering Services (Civil) of the Public Health Engineering Directorate under the Department of Public Health Engineering, Government of West Bengal and shall take effect from 1st April 1984.

PART I
Cadre

2. (a) There shall be the following two services, namely:—

- (i) The West Bengal Senior Public Health Engineering Service (Civil) consisting of the posts of Chief Engineer, Superintendent Engineer (Civil) and Executive Engineer (Civil);
- (ii) The West Bengal Public Health Engineering Service (Civil) consisting of the posts of Assistant Engineer (Civil);
- (iii) These two services shall comprise all the Group 'A' posts permanent or temporary of Civil Engineers in the Directorate of Public Health Engineering existing on the date on which these rules come into force and shall include all such posts of Civil Engineer as may be sanctioned hereafter by the State Government from time to time.

PART II

Recruitment Rules

3. Chief Engineer: (A) Method of Recruitment: Recruitment to the post of Chief Engineer shall normally be made by promotion from the post of Superintending Engineer (Civil) provided that the State Government may, at its discretion fill up the post of Chief Engineer by direct recruitment on the recommendation of the Public Service Commission, West Bengal.

(B) Qualifications for direct recruitment: Essential: (i) A degree in Civil Engineering from any recognised University or its equivalent;

(ii) At least 12 years' Experience as a Civil Engineer of which not less than 10 years must have been spent in the Public Health Engineering works including investigation, planning, design and execution of water supply scheme, sewerage scheme, sewerage purification works and other sanitary works.

(iii) Corporate membership of a recognised Professional Institute.

Desirable: (i) Experience in Town Planning, Malaria Control and Sanitation, and

(ii) Knowledge of pumping machinery on electric, Steam and oil driven.

Age: Between 40 and 50 years on the 1st January of the year of advertisement relaxable for otherwise well qualified and experience candidates.

4. Superintending Engineer (Civil): Recruitment to the posts of Superintending Engineer (Civil) shall be made by promotion from the ranks of confirmed Executive Engineer (Civil).

5. Executive Engineer (Civil): (i) Subject to the provision of Sub-Rule (2), the posts of Executive Engineer (Civil) shall ordinarily be filled up by promotion from the rank of confirmed Assistant Engineer (Civil), the selection being made by the Public Service Commission, West Bengal.

Provided that if sufficient number of Assistant Engineers suitable for such promotion be not available at any time, the posts may be filled up by direct recruitment, departmental candidates being eligible to apply.

Qualification for direct recruitment: Essential: (i) A Degree in Civil Engineering from a recognised University or equivalent qualification;

(ii) Six years' experience in Civil engineering including Sanitary Engineering and Water Supply Works.

Desirable: Preference will be given to candidates possessing post graduate degree in Public Health Engineering.

Age: Not more than 40 years on the 1st January of the year of advertisement.

(2) Notwithstanding anything contained in any other rules, an Assistant Engineering shall be eligible for promotion to the rank of Executive Engineer after he has completed six years' of service as Assistant Engineer and has passed the Examinations to be conducted by the Public Service Commission, West Bengal, which will be of the same standard as the Departmental and Professional Examinations as referred to in Chapters V and VI of the Services (Training and Examination) Rules, West Bengal at any stage of his service.

6. Assistant Engineer (Civil): (A) 60% of the total posts of Assistant Engineer (Permanent and Temporary) taken together shall be filled up by direct recruitment on the results of a competitive examination to be conducted by the Public Service Commission, West Bengal provided that the Government may fill up in the exigencies of the Public Service vacant posts of Assistant Engineer in the direct recruitment quota by Selection through Public Service Commission, West Bengal after advertisement and interview instead of by a competitive examination.

(B) The remaining 40% of the total posts of Assistant Engineers (permanent and Temporary taken together) shall be filled up by promotion from amongst the confirmed Sub-Assistant engineers (Civil) by selection through the Public Service Commission, West Bengal subject to the provision of sub-rule (d) below. Provided that if on any occasion suitable departmental candidates for promotion are not available, the State Government may in its discretion fill up a post in the promotion quota by direct recruitment through the Public Service Commission, West Bengal in the manner stated in Sub-rule (a) if in the interest of public service such post cannot be kept vacant.

(c) Qualification for direct recruitment: Essential: A degree in Civil engineering of a recognised University or equivalent qualifications.

Desirable: One year's post-graduate practical training or study or research or practical engineering experience.

Age: Not more than 30 years on the 1st January of the year of advertisement, the age-limit being relaxable in the case of a candidate who has been in the employment of the Central or the State Government or in Statutory Bodies recognised for the purpose by Government and are not out of such employment for more than a year on the said date to the extent of the actual period spent continuously in such employment.

No candidate will be allowed to take more than three chances. The departmental candidates are eligible to apply provide they fulfil the requisite qualifications.

(D) In order to be eligible for promotion to the rank of Assistant Engineer (Civil), a sub-Assistant Engineer (Civil) must fulfil the following conditions:-

(i) He must render a minimum of 10 (ten) years' continuous service as a Sub-Assistant Engineer in the regular establishment under Public Health Engineering Directorate, West Bengal;

(ii) He must be confirmed in the post of Sub-Assistant Engineer;

(iii) He must pass an examination to be conducted by the Public Service Commission, West Bengal, which will be of the same standard as the Professional Examination referred to in Chapter VI of the Services (Training and Examination) Rules, West Bengal. Provided that a sub-Assistant Engineer (Civil) who has rendered a minimum of 8 (eight) years' service including temporary service in a post of Sub-Assistant engineer in the regular establishment shall be eligible for appearing at the said examination.

PART III

7. Regularisation of certain appointments: Notwithstanding anything contained in these rules, any person recruited to the Engineering Services (Civil) under the Public Health Engineering Directorate under administrative control of the Department of Public Health Engineering, Government of West Bengal between the period from 1-4-1984 to the date of notification of these rules shall be deemed to have been duly recruited under these rules.

1. These rules shall apply to the members of the Engineering Service (Mechanical/Electrical) of Public Health Engineering Directorate under the Department of Public Health Engineering, Government of West Bengal and shall take effect from 1st April 1984.

PART I

Centre

2. (a) There shall be the following two services, namely:—

- (i) The West Bengal Senior Public Health Engineering Service (Mechanical/Electrical) consisting of the posts of Chief Engineer, Superintendent Engineer (Mechanical/Electrical) and Executive Engineer (Mechanical/Electrical);
- (ii) The West Bengal Public Health Engineering Service (Mechanical/Electrical) consisting of the posts of Assistant Engineer (Mechanical/Electrical);
- (iii) These two services shall comprise all the Group 'A' posts permanent or temporary of Mechanical/Electrical Engineers in the Directorate of Public Health Engineering existing on the date on which these rules come into force and shall include all such posts of Mechanical/Electrical Engineers as may be sanctioned hereafter by the State Government from time to time.

PART II

Recruitment Rules

3. Chief Engineer: (A) Method of Recruitment: Recruitment to the post of Chief Engineer shall normally be made by promotion from the post of Superintending Engineer (Mechanical/Electrical) provided that the State Government may, at its discretion fill up the post of Chief Engineer by direct recruitment on the recommendation of the Public Service Commission, West Bengal.

(B) Qualification for direct recruitment: Essential: (i) A degree in Mechanical/Electrical Engineering from any recognised University or its equivalent;

(ii) At least 12 years' Experience as a Mechanical/Electrical Engineer of which not less than 10 years must have been spent in the Public Health Engineering works including execution and maintenance of water supply scheme, sewerage scheme, sewerage purification works and other sanitary works.

(iii) Corporate membership of a recognised Professional Institute.

Desirable: Experience in Town Planning, Malaria Control and Sanitation.

Age: Between 40 and 50 years on the 1st January of the year of advertisement relaxable for otherwise well qualified and experienced candidates.

4. Superintending Engineer (Mechanical/Electrical): Recruitment to the posts of Superintending Engineer (Mechanical/Electrical) shall be made by promotion from the ranks of confirmed Executive Engineer (Mechanical/Electrical).

Provided that if sufficient number of Assistant Engineers (Mechanical/Electrical) suitable for such promotion be not available at any time, the posts may be filled up by direct recruitment, departmental candidates being eligible to apply.

Qualification for direct recruitment: Essential: (i) A Degree in Mechanical/Electrical Engineering from a recognised University or an equal qualification;

(ii) Six years' experience in the operation and maintenance of Water Supply Sewage disposal plant with electrical installation and mechanical equipment and its operation thereat.

Desirable: Preference will be given to candidates possessing post graduate degree in Public Health Engineering.

Age: Not more than 30 years on the 1st January of the year of advertisement.

(2) Notwithstanding anything contained in any other rules, an Assistant Engineer (Mechanical/Electrical) shall be eligible for promotion to the rank of Executive Engineer (Mechanical/Electrical) after he has completed six years' of service as Assistant Engineer and has passed the Examinations to be conducted by the Public Service Commission, West Bengal, which will be of the same standard as the Departmental and Professional Examination as referred to in Chapter V and VI of the Services (Training and Examination) Rules, West Bengal at any stage of his service.

Assistant Engineer (Mechanical/Electrical) : (A) 60% of the total posts of Assistant Engineer (Permanent and Temporary) taken together shall be filled up by direct recruitment on the results of a competitive examination to be conducted by the Public Service Commission, West Bengal provided that the Governor may fill up in the exigencies of the Public Service vacant posts of Assistant Engineer in the direct recruitment quota by Selection through Public Service Commission, West Bengal after advertisement and interview instead of by a competitive examination.

(B) The remaining 40% of the total posts of Assistant Engineers (permanent and Temporary taken together) shall be filled up by promotion from amongst the confirmed Sub-Assistant engineers (Mechanical/Sub-Assistant Engineers Electrical or electrical Supervisor), by selection through the Public Service Commission, West Bengal subject to the provision of sub-rule (d) below. Provided that if on any occasion suitable departmental candidates for promotion are not available, the State Government may in its discretion fill up a post in the promotion quota by direct recruitment through the Public Service Commission, West Bengal in the manner stated in Sub-rule (a) if in the interest of public service such post cannot be kept vacant.

(c) Qualification for direct recruitment: Essential: A degree in Mechanical/Electrical Engineering of a recognised University or equivalent qualification.

Desirable: One year's post graduate practical training or Study of research or practical engineering experience.

Age: Not more than 30 years on the 1st January of the year of advertisement, the age-limit being relaxable in the case of a candidate who has been in the employment of the Central or the State Government or in Statutory Bodies recognised for the purpose by Government and out of such employment for more than a year on the said date to the extent of the actual period spent continuously in such employment.

No candidate will be allowed to take more than three chances. The departmental candidates are eligible to apply provide supervisor they hold the requisite qualifications.

(D) In order to be eligible for promotion to the rank of Assistant Engineer a sub-Assistant Engineer (Mechanical/Electrical) Supervisor shall fulfil the following conditions:—

(i) He must render a minimum of 10 (ten) years' continuous service as a Sub-Assistant Engineer (Mechanical/Electrical) Supervisor in the regular establishment under Public Health Engineering Directorate, West Bengal;

(ii) He must be confirmed in the post of Sub-Assistant Engineer (Mechanical/Electrical) Supervisor;

(iii) He must pass an examination to be conducted by the Public Service Commission, West Bengal, which will be of the same standard as the Professional Examination referred to in Chapter VI of the Services (Training and Examination) Rules, West Bengal. Provided that a sub-Assistant Engineer (Mechanical/Electrical) Supervisor who has rendered a minimum of 8 (eight) years' service including temporary service in a post of Sub-Assistant Engineer/Electrical Supervisor in the regular establishment shall be eligible for appearing at the said examination.

Regulation of certain appointments: Notwithstanding anything contained in these rules, any person recruited to the Engineering Services (Mechanical/Electrical) under the Public Health Engineering Directorate under administrative control of the Department of Public Health Engineering, Government of West Bengal between the period from 1-1-1961 to the date of notification of these rules shall be deemed to have been recruited under these rules.

“3A. **Method of recruitment to the post of Senior Superintending Engineer (Civil):** Recruitment to the post of Senior Superintending Engineer (Civil) shall be made by promotion from the rank of Superintending Engineer (Civil) belonging to the West Bengal Senior Public Health Engineering Service (Civil), only after rendering a minimum of 26 years continuous and satisfactory service from Assistant Engineer onward, on the date of occurrence of vacancy.”

“3B. **Method of recruitment to the post of Additional Secretary (Technical) (in the rank of Senior Superintending Engineer (Civil)) :** Recruitment to the post of Additional Secretary (Technical) in the rank of Senior Superintending Engineer (Civil) shall be made by promotion from the rank of Superintending Engineer (Civil) or Joint Secretary (Technical) in the rank of Superintending Engineer (Civil) belonging to the West Bengal Senior Public Health Engineering Service (Civil), only after rendering a minimum of 26 years continuous and satisfactory service from Assistant Engineer onward on the date of occurrence of vacancy.”
