

NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the power conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor is pleased hereby to make the following rules regulating recruitment to the post of Nurse Practitioner in Midwifery in the West Bengal General Service under the Department of Health and Family Welfare, Government of West Bengal.

Rules

The method of, and the qualification required for, recruitment to the post of Nurse Practitioner in Midwifery in the West Bengal General Service under the Department of Health and Family Welfare, Government of West Bengal, shall be as detailed below:—

Name of the post: Nurse Practitioner in Midwifery;

A. Method of recruitment:

By selection (direct recruitment) through the Public Service Commission, West Bengal;

B. Essential Qualifications:

(i) B.Sc. (Nursing) Degree acquired from a College of Nursing recognized by Indian Nursing Council and West Bengal Nursing Council;

- (i) Possess Diploma in Nurse Practitioner or Midwifery course of not less than one year duration, certified by Indian Nursing Council and West Bengal Nursing Council.
- (ii) Registered as female nurse with the West Bengal Nursing Council.

C. Age:

Not more than 45 years on the 1st day of January of the year of advertisement.

Provided that the age may be relaxed for the candidates belonging to the categories of Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes as per Government Order etc. for the time being in force.
