ANNEXURE-I

Plan of Examination

Competitive Examination and Tests for recruitment to the post of "Agragami" in the West Bengal National Volunteers Force Organization shall be as follows:-

- a. **Physical Measurement Test (PMT) & Physical Efficiency Test (PET):** The Physical Measurement Test (PMT) relating to the height, weight and chest of the candidates shall be taken followed by the Physical Efficiency Test (PET) of the eligible candidates as specified in Sub-Rule 1(B). Only the Qualified candidates of PMT will be eligible to appear in PET. These tests shall be conducted by the West Bengal Police Recruitment Board at the venues selected by the Board for the purpose. Only qualified candidates of both Physical Measurement Test and Physical Efficiency Test shall be eligible to appear in the Final Competitive Examination.
- b. **Final Competitive Examination [Written Examination (Full Marks 85) and Interview (Full Marks 15) (Total 100 Marks)]:**
  - i. **Written Examination (Full Marks 85):** All those candidates who have passed all qualifying tests will appear in the Final Competitive Examination which would be a written examination. Recruiting Agency will be the competent agency to decide Scheme, Duration, Syllabus and cut-off marks for each category and post taking into account the number of vacancy to call for the Interview. The marks obtained in the Written Examination will be taken into consideration for preparation of the merit list for selection along with the marks obtained in the interview. An outline of the syllabus is mentioned below.
  - ii. **Interview (Full Marks 15):** A limited number of candidates will be called for Interview in accordance with merit. The minimum marks for getting the interview call, will be decided by the Recruiting Agency. The marks obtained in interview will also be taken into consideration while preparing the final merit list. This 15 marks is inclusive of 5 (five) marks earmarked exclusively for Special Achievements (like computer literacy, driving ability, diving, NCC course, special attainments in Sports etc.).

Syllabus for the Final Competitive Examination/written examination

Questions shall be set to test the general knowledge of the candidate including his awareness to current affairs in different spheres of life with special emphasis on West Bengal. Questions in Arithmetic shall be set on the basis of the syllabus upto Madhyamik Examination of West Bengal Board of Secondary Education. This will be a Multiple-Choice-Objective type written examination of 85 marks.
