Dated, Calcutta, the 31st August, 1965

In exercise of the power conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor is pleased hereby to make the following rules regulating the recruitment to the posts of Assistant Chemist, Chemical Assistant, Geo-Hydrological/Geological Assistant, Geo-Physical Assistant, Laboratory Assistant and Field Assistant under the State Water Investigation Directorate of the Agriculture Department, Minor Irrigation Wing, Government of West Bengal:-

Rules

The method of, and the qualifications required for, recruitment to the posts of Assistant Chemist, Chemical Assistant, Geo-Hydrological/Geological Assistant, Geo-Physical Assistant, Laboratory Assistant and Field Assistant under the State Water Investigation Directorate of the Agriculture Department, Minor Irrigation Wing, Government of West Bengal, shall be as detailed below:-

1. Assistant Chemist:

A. Method of Recruitment:

(a) 40% by promotion of confirmed Chemical Assistants under the State Water Investigation Directorate having served as such for 5 (five) years,

and

(b) 60% by selection (direct recruitment).

B. Qualifications for Direct Recruitment:

(i) B.Sc. (2nd Class) in Chemistry,

or,

(ii) B.Sc. (Hons.) in Chemistry having two years' experience in chemical laboratory work or water analysis in a reputed or established laboratory.

C. Age for direct recruitment:

Not more than 30 years on the 1st day of January of the year of recruitment.

2. Chemical Assistant:

A. Method of Recruitment:

(a) By promotion of confirmed Laboratory Assistants under the State Water Investigation Directorate having qualification of a direct recruit or having served as Laboratory Assistant for 5 (six) years.

or,

(b) By direct recruitment, if no suitable candidate is available for promotion.

B. Qualifications for direct recruitment:

(i) B.Sc. (Hons.) in Chemistry,

or,

(ii) B.Sc. with Chemistry as one of the subjects, having 3 (three) years' experience in a reputed or established chemical laboratory.

C. Age for direct recruitment:

Not more than 30 years on the 1st day of January of the year of recruitment.

3. Geo-Hydrological/Geological Assistants:

A. Method of Recruitment:

By direct recruitment.

B. Qualifications for direct recruitment:

2nd Class B.Sc. (Hons.) or M.Sc. in Geology or Applied Geology from any recognised University or its equivalent.

C. Age:

Not more than 25 years on the first day of January of the year of recruitment, relaxable for candidates belonging to S.C./S.T., as per rules.

4. Geo-Physical Assistant:

A. Method of recruitment:

~~By direct recruitment.~~

B. Qualifications for direct recruitment:

2nd Class B.Sc. (Hons.) or B.Sc. in Geophysics from any recognised University or its equivalent.

C. Age:

Not more than 25 years on the 1st day of January of the year of recruitment, relaxable for candidates belonging to S.C./S.T., as per rules.

B. Laboratory Assistant:

A. Method of Recruitment:

By direct recruitment.

B. Qualifications for direct recruitment:

(Higher Secondary (Science) passed in 2nd Division with Chemistry as one of the subjects.) Preference will be given to the candidate having any chemical laboratory experience in a reputed or established chemical laboratory.

C. Age:

Not more than 25 years on the 1st day of January of the year of recruitment.

6. Field Assistant:

A. Method of Recruitment:

By Direct recruitment.

B. Qualifications for direct recruitment:

School Final (2nd Division) or its equivalent, being conversant with all measurement systems.

C. Age:

Not more than 25 years on the 1st day of January of the year of recruitment, relaxable for candidates belong to S.C./S.T., as per rules.

Note 1:- Persons already recruited to different categories of posts as mentioned against serials 1 to 6 shall be deemed to have been recruited on regular basis to the said categories of posts in accordance with the provisions of these rules, provided they possess the minimum recruitment qualifications as set forth for each of the categories of posts as aforesaid.
