NOTIFICATION

No. 1902 - Estab (Cell II) / 12A-16/2004. Dated, 16th September, 2005

In exercise of the power conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor is pleased hereby to make, in supersession of all previous rules issued on the subject, the following rules regarding the recruitment to the posts of Assistant Chemist, Geo-Hydrological / Geological Assistant and Geo-Physical Assistant in the State Water Investigation Directorate under the Water Investigation and Development Department, Government of West Bengal :-

Rules

The method of, and the qualifications required for, recruitment to the posts of Assistant Chemist, Geo-Hydrological / Geological Assistant and Geo-Physical Assistant in the State Water Investigation Directorate under the Water Investigation and Development Department, Government of West Bengal, shall be as detailed below :-

1. Name of the post :-

Assistant Chemist

A. Method of recruitment

(a) 40% by promotion, in consultation with Public Service Commission, West Bengal, of confirmed Chemical Assistants under the State Water Investigation Directorate having at least 5 (five) years' service as such;

and

(b) 60% by selection (direct recruitment), through Public Service Commission, West Bengal

B. Qualification for Direct Recruitment

(i) A Second Class Master's Degree in Chemistry from a recognized University,

or

- (ii) A Second Class Hons. Degree in Chemistry from a recognized University having at least two years' experience in chemical laboratory works or water analysis in an organization or established laboratory of repute.

C. Age for direct recruitment :

Not more than 32 years on the 1st day of January of the year of advertisement. Age is relaxable for the candidates having higher qualification and / or longer experience than those prescribed for direct recruitment.

2. Name of the post : Geo-Hydrologist / Geologist Assistant :

A. Method of recruitment :

By selection (direct recruitment), through Public Service Commission, West Bengal

B. Qualification for Direct Recruitment :

A 2nd Class Hons. Degree or Master's Degree in Geology or Applied Geology from a recognized University or its equivalent.

C. Age for direct recruitment :

Not more than 32 years on the 1st day of January of the year of advertisement.

3. Name of the post : Geo-Physical Assistant :

A. Method of recruitment :

By selection (direct recruitment), through Public Service Commission, West Bengal

B. Qualification for Direct Recruitment :

A 2nd Class Hons. Degree or Master's Degree in Geophysics from a recognized University or its equivalent.

C. Age for direct recruitment :

Not more than 32 years on the 1st day of January of the year of advertisement
