In exercise of the power conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor is pleased hereby to make the following rules regulating the recruitment to the post of Superintending Geologist in the State Water Investigation Directorate under the Water Investigation and Development Department, Government of West Bengal:

R u l e s

The method of, and the qualifications required for, recruitment to the post of Superintending Geologist in the State Water Investigation Directorate under the Water Investigation and Development Department, Government of West Bengal, shall be as detailed below:

Method of recruitment:

- a) By selection (direct recruitment), departmental candidates being eligible to apply; or
- b) By promotion of confirmed Senior Geologist under the State Water Investigation Directorate having at least six years' service as such; or
- c) By promotion from the Senior Geologists of the State Water Investigation Directorate having rendered at least 15(fifteen) years' satisfactory service as Geologist and Senior Geologist including at least 3(three) years' service as Senior Geologist under the said directorate; or
- d) By transfer of officers from the Central Government/State Government in the scale of pay comparable to that of Superintending Geologist, and having qualification prescribed for direct recruitment

Qualification for direct recruitment:

Essential:

- i) A Doctorate or a First Class Master's Degree in Geology or Applied Geology of a recognized University/Institute or a Diploma in Applied Geology from Indian School of Mines and Applied Geology, Dhanbad or Equivalent;
- ii) Ten years' experience in a responsible position dealing with Ground Water Investigation in Alluvial and Hard Rock Terrain.

Desirable:

Administrative experience.



C. Age:

Not more than 45 years on the 1st day of January of the year of advertisement relaxable for the persons having higher qualifications and/or longer experience than those prescribed and also for persons in Government service or in the service of a statutory organization recognized by Government for the purpose.
