In exercise of the power conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor is pleased hereby to make, supersession of all previous rules issued on the subject, the following rules regulating the recruitment to the posts of Additional Director (Engg. Wing) and Additional Director (Barch Scientist) in the State Water Investigation Directorate under the Water Investigation and Development Department, Government of West Bengal:

R u l e s

The method of, and the qualifications required for recruitment to the posts of Additional Director (Engg. Wing) and Additional Director (Barch Scientist) in the State Water Investigation Directorate under the Water Investigation and Development Department, Government of West Bengal shall be as detailed below:

I. Name of the post : Additional Director (Engg. Wing).

II. Method of recruitment :

- i) By selection (direct recruitment), Departmental candidates having requisite qualifications are eligible to apply;
- ii) By deputation from Central or Other Departments of State Government or from recognized Universities/Institutions like I.I.T., University of Roorki, C.G.W.B. etc. having essential qualifications for direct recruitment;
- iii) By promotions of the officers in the rank of Super-intending Engineer (Agri-Irrigation) possessing essential qualifications for direct recruitment.

Provided that the Government can transfer such officer as Additional Chief Engineer in Water Resources Development Directorate in the interest of public Service if deemed necessary.

The post will ordinarily be filled up by promotion but if no suitable candidate is available at any point of time, the post may be filled up by Selection (direct recruitment) or by deputation as provided at clause (i) and (ii) above.

III. Qualifications for Direct Recruitment:

Essential:

- i) A First Class Degree in Civil Engineering and a post-graduate degree/diploma in Hydrology from a recognized University/Institution;
- ii) At least 8 years' experience in the field of investigation and development of Water Resources.

Desirables

- i) A Ph.D. Degree in the field of Engineering or allied discipline;
- ii) Special aptitude/outstanding research work in the field of Hydrology/Environmental Science.

IV. Age: Not more than 50 years on the 1st day of January of the year of advertisement, relaxable for the candidates having higher qualifications and/or longer experience than those prescribed.

B. I. Name of the post : Additional Director (Earth Scientist)

II. Method of recruitment:

- i) By selection (direct recruitment). Departmental candidates having requisite qualifications are eligible to apply;
- ii) By deputation from Central or Other Departments of State Government or from recognized Universities/Institutions like I.I.T., University of Roorkee, C.G.W.B. etc. having essential qualifications for direct recruitment;
- iii) By promotion of Superintending Geologist/Superintending Hydrologist of the Department possessing essential qualification mentioned at III (i) for direct recruitment and having at least 8 years' serving experience in State Water Investigation Directorate.

Note: The post will ordinarily be filled up by promotion but if no suitable candidate is available at any point of time, the post may be filled up by selection (direct recruitment) or by deputation as provided at clause (i) and (ii) above.

III. Qualifications for Direct Recruitment:

Essential:

- i) A post-graduate degree/diploma in Hydrology or post-graduate degree in Geology/Geophysics from a recognized University/Institution;
- ii) At least 8 years' experience in the field of investigation and development of water resources.

Desirable;

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- i) A D.Sc. or Ph.D. Degree in any subject mentioned in III (i) above;
 - ii) Special aptitude/outstanding research work in the field of Hydrology/Geology/Geophysics/Environmental Science.

IV. Age: Not more than 50 years on the 1st day of January of the year of advertisement, relaxable for the candidates having higher qualifications and/or longer experience than those prescribed.
